

Summerschool "make it"

Microcontroller and keen Electronics for the Internet of Things

Where: Porto – FEUP (41°10'43.4"N 8°35'46.5"W)

When: 19.-30. August 2019

Who should participate: Students from Engineering – Bachelor Programs.

This Summerschool is designed for Computer Science / IT – students with no pre knowledge about electronics. Bring your own laptop! (Windows OS recommended)

Costs: No fees for attending! – Travelling costs need to be paid by the individual

Sponsoring: ST-Microelectronics supports every participant with a STM32-Nucleo



Content: The basics of microcontroller programming as well as the necessary electronics basics are taught to enable the participants to realize their own ideas (make it!). During these two weeks 40 students are supervised by teachers from Limerick, Nuremberg and Vienna (5 full-day Hands-On-Sessions) and finish with a 2-day hackathon in which small groups realize their own projects.
